Customers simply plug the modem into an electrical outlet and into their computer to create the high speed access connection.

“SpeedNet is the “next generation” broadband-wireless high speed service delivered to the consumer in a manner that is easier to purchase, set up and use than other options currently offered,” said Moore.

Anyone can purchase SpeedNet service at select retail locations, take it home, set it up, and be online in minutes. It features plug-and-play installation – and in most cases there is no need for a technician to complete the installation. In addition, customers can move the service from place to place inside SpeedNet’s coverage area.
