**SpeedNet Wireless Internet and Digital Telephone Services
Now Available in Saginaw Twp.**

September 14, 2005, Saginaw, MI – In a continuing expansion program, SpeedNet LLC, Michigan's largest, hi-speed, wireless internet provider, announced service availability in Saginaw Twp., MI, with the installation of an Omni tower placed on top of the Saginaw Twp. Water Tower. The move will provide area residents with exceptional wireless Internet service and extends SpeedNet's market area to reach from Grand Blanc to Alpena, and from Mt. Pleasant to Caro.

"This is a great opportunity for the people of Saginaw Twp.," commented John Ogren, president and CEO of SpeedNet. "SpeedNet's wireless services offer residents, businesses, schools and government entities ubiquitous hi-speed internet connection in an ultra-wide area – this includes coverage in communities that cable and DSL fail to serve. Plus, the service is available to Saginaw Twp. residents at less than half the price offered by other internet providers - \$19.95 per month."

In addition to traditional residential and business Internet service, SpeedNet also offers digital telephone services. Customers can enjoy unlimited local and long distance calling in the US and Canada for as low as \$29.95.

SpeedNet Internet services are unlike that of cable and DSL as the company utilizes next-generation, non-line-of-sight technology (precursors for what will be commonly known as Wi-MAX) delivered through licensed bandwidths to send its signal. The technology allows customers to connect to the Internet via a signal sent across the airwaves rather than across wires resulting in an exceptionally fast, secure and reliable wireless Internet connection.

"Imagine hi-speed internet on-the-run," continued Ogren. "These broadband connections go with you, do not require a cable, DSL or a satellite connection and work within moving vehicles, offices, buildings, schools and homes. They are many times faster and more robust than cable or DSL and do not require an external antenna."

Saginaw-based SpeedNet was founded in early 2001, by Robert Liggett, Jr. and John Ogren. The Company currently offers wireless internet services to numerous cities including Bay City, Saginaw, Midland, Alpena, Caro, Mt. Pleasant, Pinconning, Reese and Clio. Upcoming tower launches are planned for Bad Axe, Frankenmuth, Bridgeport, and Delta College.

SpeedNet is the largest wireless broadband provider in Michigan and one of the top five wireless broadband companies (measured by customers) in the United States.

The company provides broadband services through the use of Federal Communications Commission (FCC) licensed Broadband Radio Service (BRS) and Educational Broadband Service (EBS). SpeedNet is the only company in Michigan deploying commercial, true non-line-of-site (NLOS) mobile broadband Internet connections.
